

# Genius of Willingness May 15, 2022

**Speaker:** Pastor Dick Foth **Scripture:** *Judges 6-8* 

**Sermon Overview:** There are 2 words that have the power to change worlds, and they are: "I WILL". Gideon modeled for us what the Genius of Willingness looks like and what God can do with a willing heart.

#### **Sermon Series Questions:**

- 1. **Discover your unique genius:** Everyone has strengths and weaknesses. What are your perceived disadvantages or weaknesses? What are your strengths and gifts?
- 2. **Develop your unique genius:** We can learn to leverage our weaknesses by partnering with God to cultivate compensatory skills. What compensatory skills do you feel God might be cultivating in you?
- 3. **Deploy your unique genius:** In what ways could your disadvantages be viewed as opportunities for your good and the good of others?

## **Sermon Specific Questions:**

- 1. What opportunities have you had to step up to with a "willing heart"?
- 2. How does serving others challenge us to step outside our comfort zone?
- 3. Have you ever felt like you were "willing" but not "ready"? How has God prepared you for that opportunity?
- 4. What might happen in your life if you said "I will" more often?

#### **Digging Deeper:**

5. Why do you think it is so important for us to act with a willing heart? How does this reflect the patience of the Father?
