## Giving Electronically With Venmo

What is Venmo? Venmo is a FREE, secure, and super useful service for collecting money and paying others all from your computer or smartphone. **It's just like PayPal, but unlike PayPal you can give money from your bank checking/savings account without any service fees.** However, if you choose to give via credit card, Venmo charges a 3% service fee.

### How to give with Venmo:

- Set up an account by downloading the Venmo app or visiting this link to sign up: <https://venmo.com/signup>
- It will give you the option of signing up with either your email address or your Facebook account.
- It will also ask for your cell phone number. It is important to give Venmo a number with text messaging capabilities, because they will send you a code via text message to activate your account. For extra security, they will also text you if any transactions have been made.
- Make sure you add a bank account. Visit this link for instructions: <https://help.venmo.com/hc/en-us/articles/209690058-How-do-I-add-a-bank-account->
- After adding a bank account, to give to National Community Church, you need to add NCC "@theaterchurch"
