

The Lord's Prayer: After Amen March 24th / 25th

Note to Leaders:

This series we are exploring the Lord's Prayer. These questions provide a framework to prompt or foster discussion. Don't feel you have to use all or any of these questions and you don't have to make it to the end! Use the questions that best fit your group and let discussion flow. You can also use these questions on your own to dive deeper into this week's sermon.

Icebreaker Suggestions:

What Easter traditions did you have growing up?

Sermon Series Questions:

- 1. What did God reveal to you?
- 2. What are you going to do about it?
- 3. What is one element of God's character you learned?

Sermon Specific Questions:

- 1. AMEN: You have to get to the amen! Pray like it depends on God but work like it depends on you. What have you been praying for that you need to act on? What is one action you can take towards it today?
- 2. Are you doing everything you can to use what God has given you to be the hands and feet of Jesus? What God given ability do you need to be cultivating when you think about what Pastor Mark said about 50% attitude (Philippians 2:5), 50% ability, 10% anointing = impact?

- 3. Pastor Mark said, "Whatever you're praying for you are volunteering for." Reflect on your prayer life. Do you pray just to be done with it or do you have intentions to follow up? What are you praying for right now and are you ready to volunteer for it?
- 4. Pastor Mark said, "Without the Holy Spirit I am below average, but I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Are you allowing Christ to work in you? How are you seeing His work?
