Series Overview

Message Overview

Sow today what you want to see tomorrow. Over time, one of two things happen. Either memory overtakes imagination or imagination overtakes memory. The difference? Prophetic imagination. It's seeing the invisible, hearing the inaudible, and believing the impossible. Add to it patient persistence and bold prayer, and it's game on.

Message-Specific Discussion Questions

What is one important thing this week that you could "do for a day"?

Read Proverbs 29:18. Vision is an expression of prophetic imagination. **How has your vision given you perspective during this season?**

You seed the clouds with prophetic imagination, patient persistence, and bold prayer. **Which of these do you think you are strongest in, and which might you be weakest in?**

In order to cultivate a prophetic imagination, you have to cultivate a prophetic ear — ears that are fine-tuned to the still small voice of the Holy Spirit. **In what ways do you typically hear the voice of God?**

Often, those within our community teach us about God and how to follow him. **Who in your life comes to mind as someone who embodies prophetic imagination, patient persistence, or bold prayer? In what ways do they exhibit these traits?**

What practices might you put in place to cultivate prophetic imagination, patient persistence, and bold prayer?
