**Scripture Focus:** Exodus 6:2-8

**Note to Leaders:**

This weekend we discussed The Exodus. These questions provide a framework to prompt or foster discussion in addition to what is in your Long Story Short Curriculum Booklet. Don't feel you have to use all or any of these questions and you don't have to make it to the end! Use the questions that best fit your group and let discussion flow.

**Sermon Series Questions:**

1. What did God reveal to you?
2. What are you going to do about it?
3. What is one element of God's character you learned?

**Specific Questions:**

1. Reread Exodus 6:2-8. What is your "Egypt?" Where do you need to experience God's promise of deliverance?
2. Sometimes the best people who can help us overcome our struggles are the ones who have already overcome. Who are you learning from and allowing to pour into your life?
3. Where do you need to believe in your life, "If God did that back then...He can do this right now"?
4. Why do you think we struggle more with the change process than with the change itself? Why do you think we try to control the factors?
5. What process do you need to walk through and not avoid? Where do you need to "stand still and see the salvation of the Lord" (Exodus 14:13, NKJV)?

6. What are you quitting because the terms you were dealt did not match what you had anticipated or hoped?
