How do we contextualize this call in our present world?

The message of the gospel doesn't change but the context of it does.

What does the good news look like here?

Jesus starts with the value or the goodness first. He then meets us at that place of hurt or pain.

We pursue shalom amidst poverty

Poverty is not just material. There is spiritual poverty, physical poverty, and social poverty.

When Jesus says Peace be with you, shalom, wholeness, He is saying my wholeness be upon you.

Action Item: Deciding your house will be a house of peace. Generous with your time, your resources, and your home.
