Greek words for love:

Eros - erotic love, sexual love, physical love.

Phileo - a kind of brotherly love or friend love.

Storge - familial love - a child to a parent or parent to a child

Agape - God is love - God exists in a community of love, a circle of relationship in Father, Son and Holy Spirit

God's action is love.

Love is who God is. Love is what God does.

John 13:34-35

Love is Patient

- it is patient with people

Patience refers to the restraint of power. It's when you have the right and ability and maybe even a really good reason to give up on someone but you choose not to.

Love is Kind - doing something useful for another person.

If patience is our posture, kindness is the action that we take.

Love does not Envy - Love doesn't put objects, possessions, or opportunities between us.

Love does not Boast - Love doesn't operate out of insecurity or arrogance. It doesn't seek to assign value based on comparison.

Love is not Proud

Love requires us to come into the presence of others with a joyful recognition - There you are!

Love does not Dishonor Others - Love doesn't deflate others.

Love is not Self Seeking - Love is about actively choosing someone else's highest good.

Love is not Easily Angered - It's not touchy. It's not easily triggered.

Love Always Hopes - Anna and Simeon - stay at the temple and wait for the coming of the messiah.

Love Always Perseveres - Endurance under suffering - Bookend to Love is Patient. The patience that God exhibited in the garden when everything fell apart.

DAILY DECLARATION: God I receive your love, poured into my heart by the power of Your Holy Spirit (Romans 5:5). I will abide in Your love for me.

WEEKLY ACTIVATION: Turn your affections to God. Set an alarm for 3 times a day to stop in the middle of the day and say "God I give you all my affections and all my attention right now." Your love for God will become missional love for others
