Sermon Overview

We need a REVIVAL of LOVE, and it starts with giving God our full attention, our full affection. It's falling in love with God all over again. During this series, we'll explore four dimensions of love — Love Unconquered, Love Regardless, Love Undistracted, and Love Unoffended.

Sermon Series Questions:

- 1. Take inventory of your love relationship with the Lord. Does it need a revival? What is distracting you from giving your full attention and affection to God?
- 2. What are the practices you are using to rekindle or sustain a REVIVAL of LOVE in your relationship with God?

Sermon Specific Questions:

- 1. Consider a time when you were at a low point. Who were the people who were your Rock of Gibraltars and helped you realize you weren't alone?
- 2. One of the names we have for God is Redeemer, which means to be brought into His family. What does it mean for you to be redeemed into God's family?
- 3. Naomi means "beautiful," but because of her difficult circumstances she felt that "bitter" was a more accurate name. In this season, do you feel more like your life looks "beautiful" or "bitter?" How are you stewarding the events of this season?
- 4. What is one way God's love has or is inviting you to have a heart-change?

Digging Deeper:

- How do you plan to actively receive God's love this week?
- How do you plan to actively give away God's love?
- Pray this prayer out loud each day this week and then lift up your own prayer of adoration:

I am no longer my own, but Yours. Put me to what you will, rank me with whom you will; Put me to doing, put me to suffering; Let me be employed for you, or laid aside for you, Exalted for you, or brought low for you; Let me be full, Let me be empty, Let me have all things, Let me have nothing: I freely and wholeheartedly yield all things To your pleasure and disposal. And now, glorious and blessed God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, You are mine and I am yours. So be it. And the covenant now I made on earth, let it be ratified in heaven. Written by, John Wesley
