Series Overview:

Message Overview:

We have a core value—the church belongs in the middle of the marketplace. We don't curse the darkness. We light candles. We're not just building a church. We're blessing a city. We want to be more known for what we're FOR than what we're AGAINST. We criticize by creating! We write better books, make better music, draft better legislation, produce better films, start better businesses. How? With the help of the Holy Spirit.

Message-Specific Discussion Questions:

What makes you mad or sad? What makes you glad? What puts a smile on your face? Could these be God-ordained dreams?

Religion vs Relationship

- Read Acts 17:18-21
- Reflect on Psalm 115. Our world shrinks to what we worship.
- God has given us all gifts & dreams. But, we can sometimes worship the gifts over the Gift Giver.
- Where have we consciously built altars to God vs monuments to self?

Criticize by creating

- Read Acts 17:22-23
- Consecration is putting our idols on the altar.
- Goodness is not the absence of badness. You can do nothing wrong and still do nothing right.
- Reflect on Matthew 10:16
- Reflect on Zechariah 4:10
- "Do not curse the darkness, light a candle"
- How can you put your gifts and dreams to action in your life this week?

Practical Application
