Soil and Spirit: 'Love Based Risk'

<u>Isaiah 65:1-2</u> - A God who says I am here.

Our culture is self-obsessed with itself but not very self-aware.

THE INVITATION: To see beyond ourselves and see a God who says "I am here".

We're not human beings having a spiritual experience, we're spiritual beings having a human experience.

We get to engage the image of God that is already in people.

What does it look like for us as a community to see Christ in every single person we encounter?

<u>Isaiah 55-65</u> - Hope with a warning.

This is the gospel according to Jesus.

Luke 4:16-18 - referencing Isaiah 61

THE MISSION OF JESUS: to restore humanity by setting the oppressed free, liberating humanity from sin and entering the freedom and relationship with God and one another He always intended for us.

By the Holy Spirit we are now sent to live out His mission to restore the world through Him.

The Missional Church is Risk Based Love

ACT

Assisting the Poor and Oppressed

Caring for the Sick and Sorrowful

Iransforming through Reconciliation

God's primary activity is in the world and the church is God's instrument sent into the world to participate in His redemptive mission.

We must be recovering the call of discipling people

As the early Church is about to start, Jesus' final words are: Acts 1:8

What does empowerment of the Spirit mean?

- We are animated by God's Spirit when we take our first breath
- We are indwelled with God's Spirit when we proclaim Jesus is Lord and begin to walk in His ways
- We are empowered to live through God's Spirit to overcome personal & communal sin over and over and over

For the early Church the Spirit is not merely an impersonal force or influence or power. The Spirit is none other than the FULFILLMENT OF THE PROMISE that God himself would once again be **present with his people**.

Empowerment is formed out of the practice of prayer and walking with Jesus that begins with thanksgiving, followed by the forgiveness of sins, and then inviting Jesus to speak over us as beloved children of God. That is where our identity is restored, and we enter the fullness of God's presence and ask to be empowered.
